2. Send your registration form and deposit fees (in Canadian or US dollars) to the Director of Admissions. Deposits may be made by money order, Visa or Master Card. If you pay by credit card, please include the complete credit card number and the expiry date.
3. We will send you a letter of acceptance. Once you have your letter, you should begin to make your travel plans to come to Prince Edward Island.
4. Make sure you have a valid passport (and visa, if necessary) for international travel.
5. Purchase health insurance. Health insurance is necessary for students studying at our school. (If you do not have health insurance when you arrive in PEI, you will be required to purchase it).

## Payment and Refund Policy

**1. Programs less than 45 days in length:** All fees must be received at least 45 days prior to the start of the program. Students who register within 45 days of the program start date are required to pay the full amount upon registration.

Students who indicate in writing, at least 45 days prior to the start of their program that they wish to withdraw from the program will receive a full refund, less the application fee and homestay placement fee (where applicable).

No refunds will be granted to students who withdraw during the 45-day period to the beginning of their program, or after their program has begun.

**2. Programs greater than 12 weeks in length:** All fees must be received at least 45 days prior to the start of the program. Students who register within 45 days of the program start date are required to pay the full amount upon registration.

Students who indicate in writing, at least 45 days prior to the start of their program that they wish to withdraw from the program will receive a full refund, less the application fee and homestay placement fee (where applicable).

Students who withdraw from the program during the 45-day period prior to the beginning of their program will be refunded all fees, less the first 12 weeks of tuition and homestay, the application fee, airport pick-up, and the homestay placement fee.
