It is a part of PEI's cultural landscape, inspiring a popular museum, multiple tourist attractions, and the longest running musical in the world.

Charlottetown: This is the capital city of PEI and is known for its historic charm, vibrant arts scene, and beauty. You can explore historic sites and enjoy local seafood, attend cultural events and festivals and much more. It's known as the "Birthplace of Confederation" because the Charlottetown Conference of 1864 led to the formation of Canada.

Confederation Bridge: Spanning 12.9 kilometers (8 miles), the Confederation Bridge is an engineering marvel that connects PEI to mainland Canada. It's the world's longest bridge over ice-covered waters and is one of Canada's greatest engineering achievements. You don't need to cross the bridge to enjoy it. You can enjoy scenic views from nearby Gateway Village, which offers great shopping and dining.
