Prince Edward Island

Prince Edward Island is unique. It is known as one of the safest places in Canada. Islanders are very friendly. It is one of few places where it is still common for people to say "hi" and smile at you when you pass them on the street. Islanders will welcome the chance to interact with you, and opportunities to do so are built in during afternoon activities. PEI is surrounded by a beautiful, calm ocean, gentle hills, vast grasslands, rare red soil, wide open skies, and clean air, all of which you will experience by joining our program.

Anne of Green Gables: This is a classic novel written by Lucy Maud Montgomery, set in PEI. It tells the story of Anne Shirley, an imaginative and spirited orphan, who comes to live at Green Gables, a farm owned by siblings Marilla and Matthew Cuthbert. The book, and its numerous sequels, have captured the hearts of readers around the world and significantly contributed to PEI's cultural landscape, inspiring a popular museum and tourist attractions dedicated to the story's setting.

Charlottetown: The capital city of PEI, Charlottetown is known for its historic charm, vibrant arts scene, and seaside beauty. It's often referred to as the "Birthplace of Confederation" due to the Charlottetown Conference of 1864, which led to the formation of Canada. Visitors can enjoy a range of activities, from exploring historic sites and enjoying local seafood, to attending cultural events and festivals.

Confederation Bridge: Spanning 12.9 kilometers (8 miles), the Confederation Bridge is an engineering marvel that connects PEI to mainland Canada (New Brunswick). Opened in 1997, it's the world's longest bridge over ice-covered waters and offers a convenient and scenic route for visitors and residents traveling by road.
